LOG LINE: What do you do when your world falls apart? You go to the happiest place on earth.

Synopsis: In 1965, 7-year-old Anna Boreman sets off on a 6-week road trip across America with her estranged, traveling minister father in search of forgiveness and Autopia.

Filmmaker statement: To create our found footage films, we start with the material we have (8mm and Super8mm vintage films) and work the story out, based on what footage we have, and using experiences and storytelling we come up with a piece. This is our 4th of this style. I have also written and directed live action feature and short films.
