LOGLINE


An aging hunter is confronted by Private Military Contractors after he crosses into private property out in the middle of the desert.

SYNOPSIS

The story of MIER accounts two days in the lives of Oupa, a San hunter/gatherer who lives alone in the desert, and Boetie, a 'coloured' boy from a nearby settlement where people were relocated to from the desert. Boetie is struggling with his own inner demons when the older man in stills his traditional values on the stubborn and proud youngster.


Over the course of the story, the greater world of these characters is revealed and we find out that they are hunting on this land illegally.





OUR STORY

MIER "The Ant" is a short film written with the expressed purpose of using it as a "proof of concept" to generate interest and financing for a feature film of the same name. "Mier" is about the San people's struggle for the Kalahari and its resources. The story is set in modern day Mier a small border town on the Tri-borders of South Africa, Namibia and Botswana. It is also a film about cultural identity and people who feel disconnected from their heritage and the short focuses on two aspects of the overall story, the **‡Khomani San and the crossroads where the modern** world meets the old world and how much this land has changed since the introduction of oil and gas drilling in the area (the cause of the displacement of the people who live there) and the introduction of **Private Military Contractors contracted to protect** these sites.



Danny Ross as Boetie



He is dishonourable, manipulative, ruthless, extremely sadistic, sexually depraved, wild, and completely capable of committing unspeakable

Isak Kruiper as Oupa

Oupa, the main protagonist is very skilled at surviving in the desert, knowing all the traditional methods handed down to him by his ancestors. He is contrasted by Boetie and his friends who are very 'modern', wearing modern clothes and carrying modern tools.



Director, *Oliver North*

Oliver North has developed the script which started in early 2019 and received PESP funding for the short film in Aug 2021 completing post production in Oct 2021 funded by the National Film and Video Foundation. Having developed the script from the MTP stage with feedback from a script editor he's taken the editor's feedback into account with each draft (five drafts in total) and has worked hard to polish the script while still retaining the original vision.

The impact of our short film is to have it screened and premiered at global film festivals given that this is the first time a film is done about the Khoisan | bushman people where they are not stereotyped in a film such as: "The Gods must be Crazy". Incidentally this film was produced and directed by 2 100% BBBEE level 1 companies and people of colour in HOD capacities. I intend to create a dialogue about illegal drilling/fracking in the Kalahari while presenting the San as authentic as possible.

Producer, Rafiq Samsodien






