

The selected short films, which range across various genres and Apulian locations, will be screened on May 30 at the Italian Cultural Institute in Los Angeles. Among the works on display are "San Vitu Rock" by Fausto Romano, "Albertine, where are you?" by Maria Guidone, "La Pescatora" by Lucia Loré, "Super Jesus" by Vito Palumbo and "Lea and the Flamingo" by Antonio De Palo. This selection, part of the "InFocus: Puglia Cinema" section of the NFMLA, enjoys the patronage of the Italian Consulate in Los Angeles.
