# **SYNOPSIS**

17-year-old Anais and Adrian burst into the motel room after prom, ready to do the deed. But as the afternoon slips into night, Anais finds herself repulsed and unsure of whether to stop. Encouraged by her friends Anais pushes on, sending her on a journey of desire, self-doubt and eventually dissociation. Anais loses her virginity, but at what cost?

"ick" is a short film about struggling to fit the boxes everyone else seems to find simple; the omissions that often exist behind the pressures of our peers; and the lies people often tell themselves after they realize they've made a mistake they can't take back.



# **DIRECTORS STATEMENT**

Ick! If you are connected to the internet in any way then you have probably heard the word. It's a term used to diagnose the feeling you get when the person you are attracted to does something or says something that suddenly makes you stand up and say, "no thank you!".

When I first heard the phrase, I laughed... and then immediately flashed back to my first experience with the internet's favorite phrase. It's a powerful, albeit silly, term and the perfect vehicle for exploring the shifting nature of desire...

The question I wanted to ask with 'ick' is: 'what it is we are really teaching young women about sex'? In the film, our lead character Anais begins to ask herself the questions that so many teenage girls do when faced with the pressure many western societies place on them to have sex. Should she stop? Can she even do that? This is what she want's... right? The conversation about consent has come a long way since I was 17, but it is still so black and white. I hope this short will start a bigger, more nuanced conversation around the topic of consent. Most women I know have experienced some form of sexual assault. This needs to be talked about.
