

## NewFilmmakers LA Announces 2024 InFocus: Latinx and Hispanic Cinema Fest Lineup

NewFilmmakers Los Angeles (NFMLA) will host the 2024 edition of InFocus: Latinx & Hispanic Cinema Film Festival from Sept. 20-21.

The Festival's two-day program will feature four short film programs with audience Q&A sessions and two live panels, including Feature Filmmaking: In Conversation with Oscar-winning Producer Daniel Dreifuss ("All Quiet on the Western Front").

The Festival will showcase 25 short films spanning narrative live-action, documentary, and animation, representing nearly a dozen countries, including Brazil, Colombia, Cuba, the Dominican Republic, El Salvador, France, Mexico, Nicaragua, Puerto Rico and the United States.

Among the selections are the Los Angeles premieres of five new short films by emerging talent from São Paulo, Brazil, the Los Angeles Premiere of "When Big People Lie" by NFMLA's Best New Filmmaker of 2024 Gianfranco Fernández-Ruiz and the world premieres of "Petalos" by NFMLA Best of Award winner Nicole Mejia, "The Mourning Of" by NFMLA alum and NewNarratives grant winner Merced Elizondo and "The Devil's Plot" by Julia Weisberg Cortés.
