## **SYNOPSIS**

**Step into the hauntingly vivid world of** *Pandaal*—a realm unlike anything you've ever known. Just as the goddess Durga brings justice to her devotees in a traditional Pandaal, here, Durga, a fierce and enigmatic female pimp, delivers her own brand of retribution. But this is no ordinary justice—she targets abusers, weaponizing their sins against them in a system she's built to protect and empower her girls.

Behind Durga's commanding presence lies a storm of hidden scars, the remnants of a harrowing past she's never fully escaped. Her world is a sanctuary for those seeking refuge—and a nightmare for those who dare to abuse.

In yet another compelling directorial venture, "Jasmine Flowers," Sanghvi crafts a poignant short film that delicately portrays the journey of an elderly Indian widow navigating societal taboos. This impactful work has garnered widespread acclaim and a host of accolades, including awards and nominations at esteemed festivals such as the "California Women's Film Festival", the "Indian Film Festival of Melbourne", and the "Nevada Women's Film Festival".

Shaily's background in psychology profoundly influences her storytelling approach. She believes that human behavior thrives in the gray areas, where no one is entirely right or wrong. This philosophy is at the core of her work, as she strives to depict the complexities and nuances of her characters, making them deeply human and relatable. This approach is evident in her other films, such as "Pandaal," "Alive," and "Haze Grey," all of which are inspired by true stories.

Before her successful career in Los Angeles, Shaily began her illustrious journey in India. #### **Director Statement**


**Pandaal** is a story that is incredibly close to my heart, as it draws inspiration from true events. Writing the script was an emotional rollercoaster because it was essential to do justice to the experiences of someone who bravely opened up about their past trauma and journey to transform it into art. Seeing their teary-eyed joy at the end of the narration was a deeply cathartic and humbling experience.

The journey of creating **Pandaal** has been nothing short of extraordinary, especially as we brought an Indian brothel to life—right here in Los Angeles! From casting to

production design, every department went above and beyond to immerse the audience and hide the fact that it was actually filmed in LA. We even conducted extensive dialect training with the cast to ensure no accents would break the authenticity of the performances. After months of scouting, a year of writing, and nearly another year of post-production, it all feels worth it.

This is a story that needs to be told—not just because abuse is an important topic to address but because it's time we stop waiting for someone else to save us. Like Durga, the protagonist, we must take matters into our own hands.

Durga is a layered character—both fearsome and vulnerable. She is the abused child, the daughter who couldn't protect her mother, and the girl who was always silenced by her father. **Pandaal** is her answer to these traumas. It is a story of pain, resilience, and ultimately, triumph.


